

AUTUMN IS HERE...

IT'S TIME FOR BULK LEAF PICK UP

The City of Plymouth Department of Municipal Services will be offering bulk leaf pick up this autumn. Please refer to the calendar at the right and the map on the reverse side to determine the assigned weeks for pick up at your address.

Residents are required to have leaves neatly raked to the curb by 7:00 A.M. on the Monday of the designated week(s). Having the leaves to the curb on time and on schedule will ensure that when we are collecting leaves on your street, your leaves will not be missed. If we are on your street on Monday and your leaves are not out to the curb, it may be a couple of weeks until we are back in your area.

REMINDERS:

- DO NOT park cars over leaf piles. Car exhaust systems may catch leaves on fire.
- DO NOT place leaf piles over storm drains. Plugged grates will cause flooding. Please take care to keep grates free of leaves, even if you have to go out in the rain to clear the grates on your street.
- DO NOT place grass clippings, branches/limbs, corn stalks, pumpkins, dirt, rocks, firewood, stumps, root balls, etc. into/onto bulk leaf piles in the street.
- If the materials listed above are placed in/on leaf piles, the leaf piles WILL NOT be picked up and it will be your responsibility to have the leaves removed.

Please place grass clippings, brush, corn stalks, pumpkins, etc. in brown lawn refuse bags or in containers labeled "compost." Weekly compost pick up will occur on your regular trash day through the end of November by the City's Solid Waste contractor.
