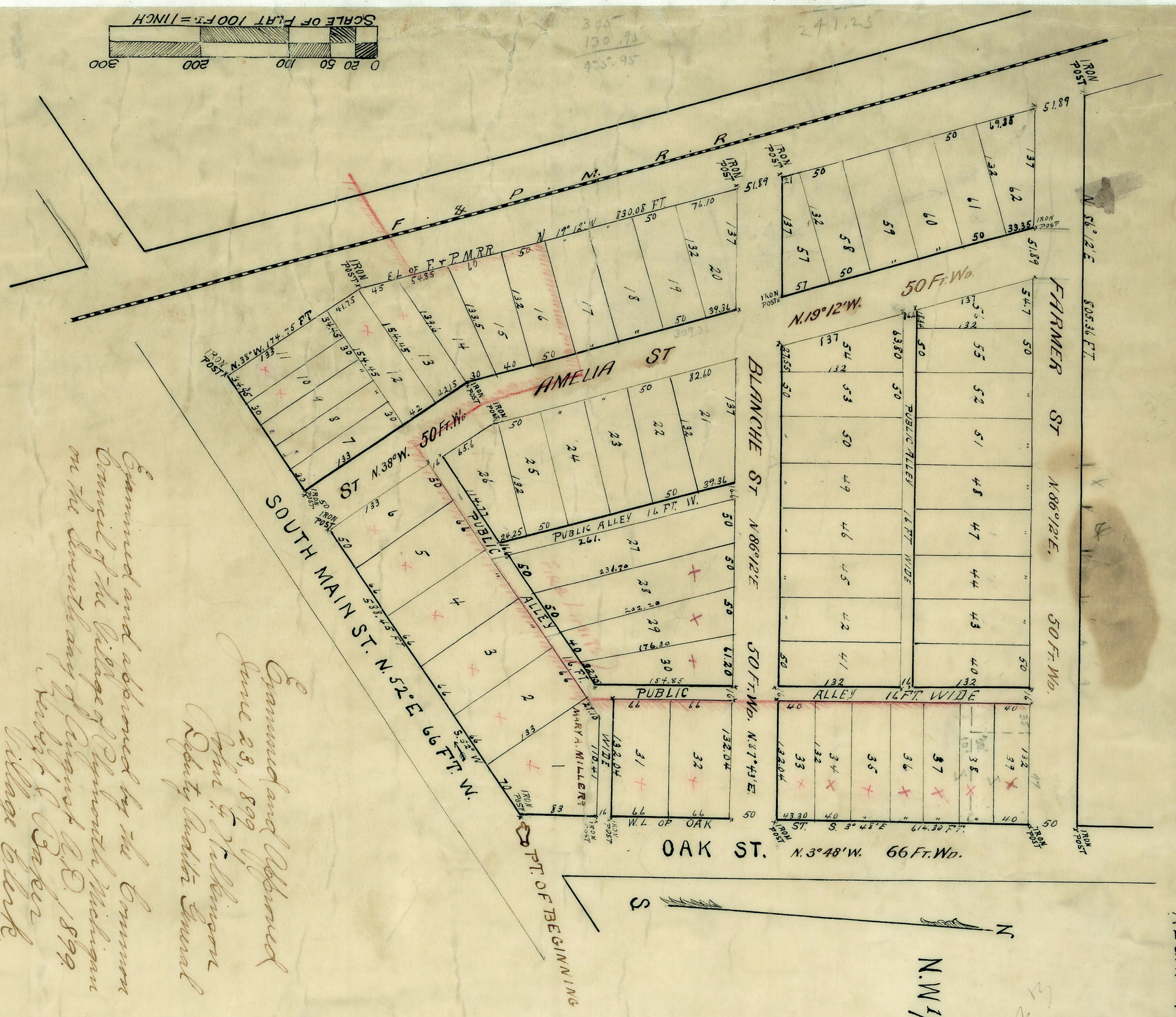


GRAVEL HILL SUB-DIVISION ON THE

Description of the land platted

The land embraced in the annexed plat of Gravel Hill Subdivision is described as follows viz: Beginning at an iron post standing on the northwest corner of South Main and Oak Streets, in said Village thence along the north line of said South Main Street S. 52° 07' 58" W. 588 1/2 feet to an iron post; thence S. 73° 38' 27" 17 1/2 feet to an iron post on the E. line of the 4th St. N. 19° 12' 17" E. 830 1/2 feet to an iron post; thence along said line N. 19° 12' 17" E. 830 1/2 feet to an iron post; thence N. 56° 12' E. 505 1/2 feet to an iron post; thence along said line E. 8° 48' E. 614 1/2 feet to the place of beginning.

That we, George A. Starkweather and Amelia Starkweather his wife and Mary A. Miller, as signers have caused the tract embraced in the annexed plat to be surveyed, and subdivided, and to be shown as Gravel Hill Subdivision and that the streets and alleys as shown said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.
