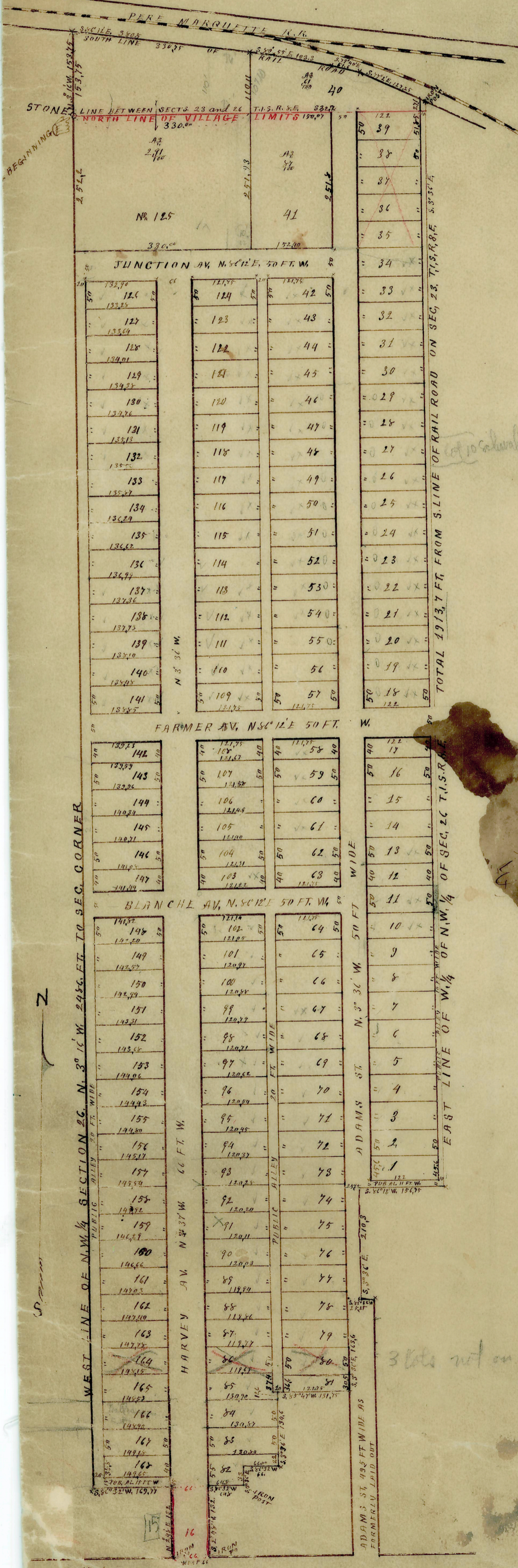

Description of the land platted
 The land embraced in the annexed plat of Kate E. Allen's addition to Plymouth Village is described as follows, Beginning at a stone at the corner of sections 22, 23, 26 and 27 in S., T. 1, S. R. 8, E., Wayne County, Michigan, Thence along the line between sections 22 and 23 N. 3° 16' W. 153.75 feet to a post on the S. line of the Pere Marquette Rail Road, Thence along said line S. 86° 12' E. 380.5 feet to a fence post, Thence S. 80° 55' E. 103.3 feet to a post, Thence S. 79° 40' E. 51.6 feet to a post, Thence S. 77° 2' E. 127.25 feet to an iron post on the E. line of the W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of said Sec. 23, Thence along said line, also the E. line of the W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of said Section 26, S. 3° 36' E., a total distance of 1913.7 feet to a post, Thence S. 86° 12' W. 156.25 feet to a post, Thence S. 3° 36' E. 210.3 feet to a post, Thence S. 86° 32' W. 25.25 feet to a post, Thence S. 3° 36' E. 143.6 feet to an iron post, Thence S. 84° 47' W. 131.25 feet to a post, Thence S. 3° 36' E. 134.6 feet to a post, Thence S. 86° 32' W. 66 feet to a post, Thence S. 3° 36' E. 33 feet to a post, Thence S. 86° 32' W. 64.8 feet to a post, at the N. E. corner of lot 16 of Kate E. Allen's addition to Park Place, Thence along the E. line of said lot S. 2° 48' W. 132 feet to an iron post on the N. line of Church St, Thence along said line west 66 feet to an iron post at the S.W. corner of said lot 16, Thence along the W. line of said lot N. 2° 48' E. 132 feet to a post, Thence S. 86° 32' W. 169.75 feet to a post on the W. line of the N.W. 1/4 of said section 26, Thence along said line N. 3° 16' W. 248.6 feet to the point of beginning.
