Beginning at the Southeast corner of Fralick's Addition to the Village of Plymouth; thence N 34° 10' E along the Southeasterly line of said Fralick's Addition 172.35 ft.; thence S 55° 40' E - 96.1 ft.; thence N 23° 50' E - 91.3 ft.; thence S 80° 42' E. along the Southerly line of Roe St. 127.75 ft.; thence S 11° 13' W. 324.20 ft.; thence N 79° 18' W. - 353.50 ft.; thence N 34° 10' E. - 123.0 ft. to the point of beginning.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS
