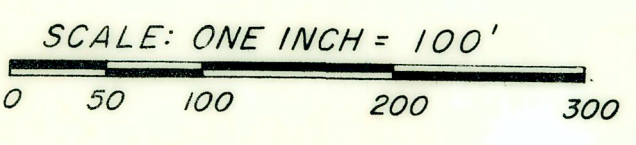


NEW ENGLAND VILLAGE SUBDIVISION

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

The land embraced in the annexed plat of New England Village Subdivision part of the N. W. 1/4 of Section 27, T. 1S., R. 8E., City of Plymouth, Wayne County, Michigan, comprises lots 1 to 126 inclusive, is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of N. Territorial Rd. distant N. 3° 22' 21" W., 683.16' along the N & S 1/4 line and N. 73° 46' 19" W., 933.32' from the center 1/4 post of Sec. 27, T. 1S., R. 8E., and proceeding thence; N. 73° 46' 19" W., 720.39' along the original centerline of N. Territorial Road, thence N. 4° 33' 10" W., 1128.73'; thence N. 86° 51' 26" E. 1069.71'; thence along the West boundary of Massermain Springdale Subdivision, (L. 81 P. 62) S. 3° 08' 34" E. 200.00'; and N. 86° 51' 26" E., 32.24'; and S. 3° 22' 21" E. 840.00'; and N. 86° 51' 26" E., 22.54'; and S. 03° 08' 34" E., 124.25'; thence N. 70° 38' 33" W., 37.27'; thence S. 86° 51' 26" W., 275.25'; thence S. 23° 52' 01" W., 243.95' to the point of beginning.

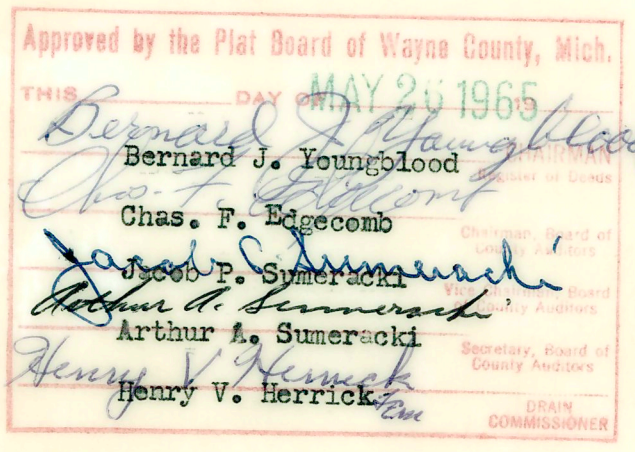
