Description:-

The land embraced in the annexed plat is described as follows:-
Beginning at the Center Post of Sect. 26, T.15. R.8.E. Plymouth Village, Wayne Co. Mich. Thence S 89°-17'E. 740.57 Ft along the E & W 1/4 line of said Sect 26 to an iron stake: thence S 1°-16'W. 310.17 Ft to an iron stake: thence S 74°-21'W 176.15 Ft to an iron stake: thence S 28°-21'W. 146.35 Ft to an iron stake: thence S 43°-51'W. 217.11 Ft. to an iron stake: thence N. 89°-10'W 131.24 Ft to an iron stake: thence N 26°-4'W. 103.07 Ft to an iron stake: thence N 88°-59'W. 166.35 Ft to an iron stake in the center line of Mill St, said center line is the N & S 1/4 line of said Sect. 26: thence North 554.00 Ft along said N & S 1/4 line to the Point of Beginning.

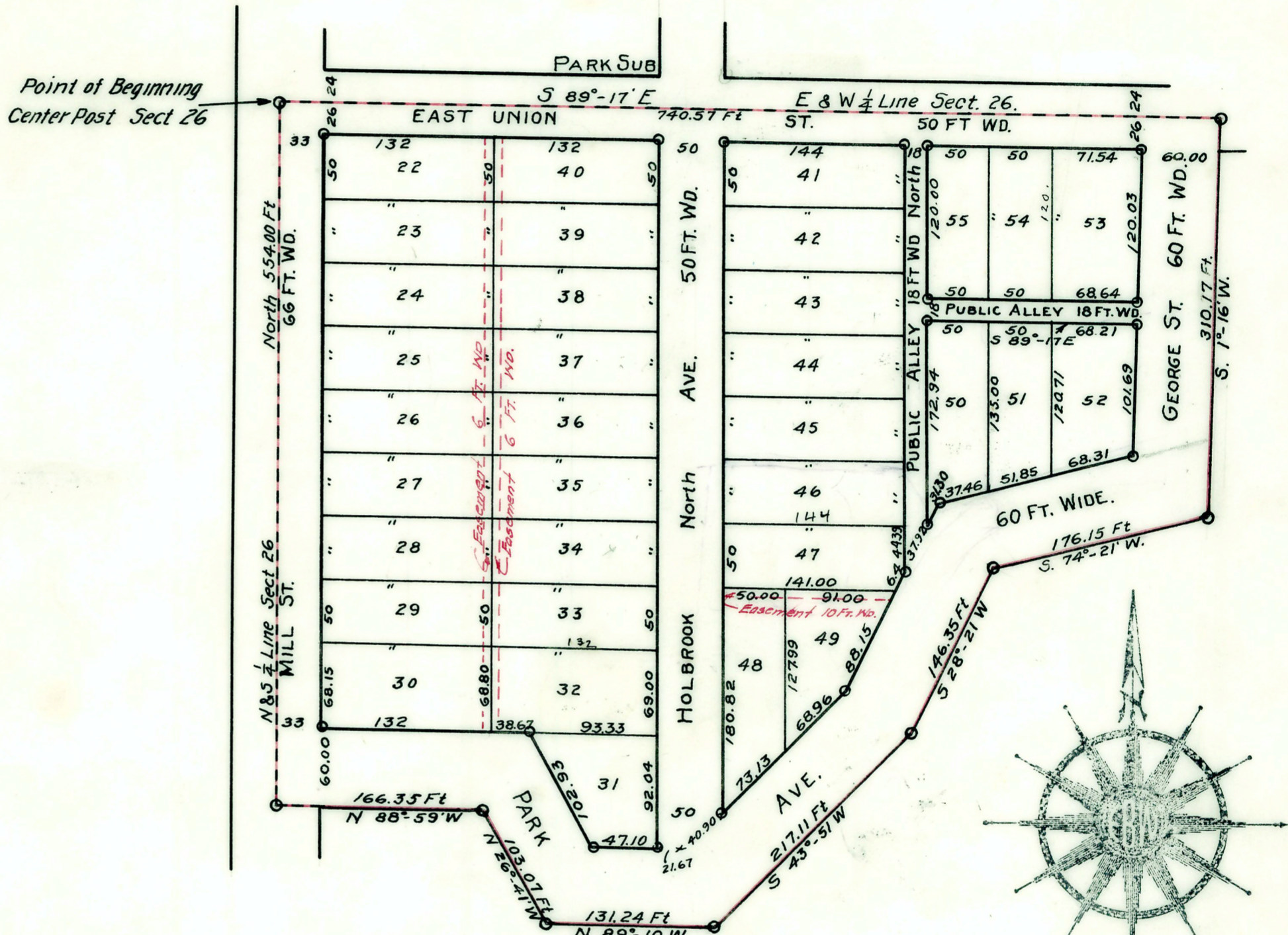
