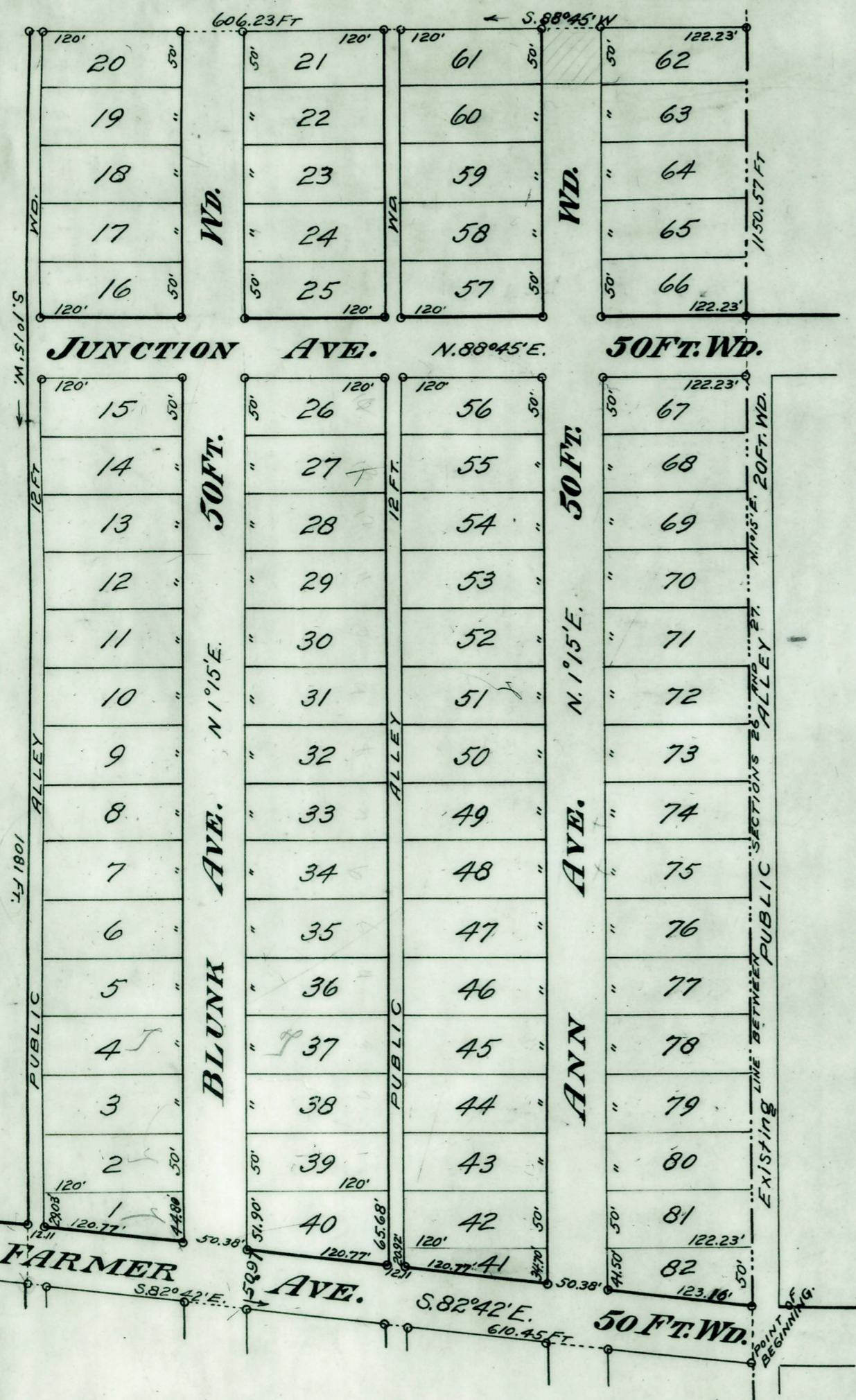

Description
The land embraced in the annexed plat of "Plymouth Heights" is described as follows - Commencing on the line between Sections 26 and 27, in T. 1. S. R. 8. E., Twp. Plymouth, Wayne Co., Michigan and the intersection of the South line of Farmer Ave, Extended, thence running along said Section line on a course of N. 1° 15' E. 1150.57 feet to an iron stake, thence S. 88° 45' W. 606.23 feet to an iron stake, thence S. 1° 15' W. 1081 feet to an iron stake on the South line of Farmer Ave, extended thence S. 82° 42' E. 610.45 feet to the point of beginning.

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one, and that permanent monuments, consisting of 1/2" by 16" iron pipes have been planted at points marked thus (Ø) as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land plated, and at all intersections of streets or streets and alleys.
