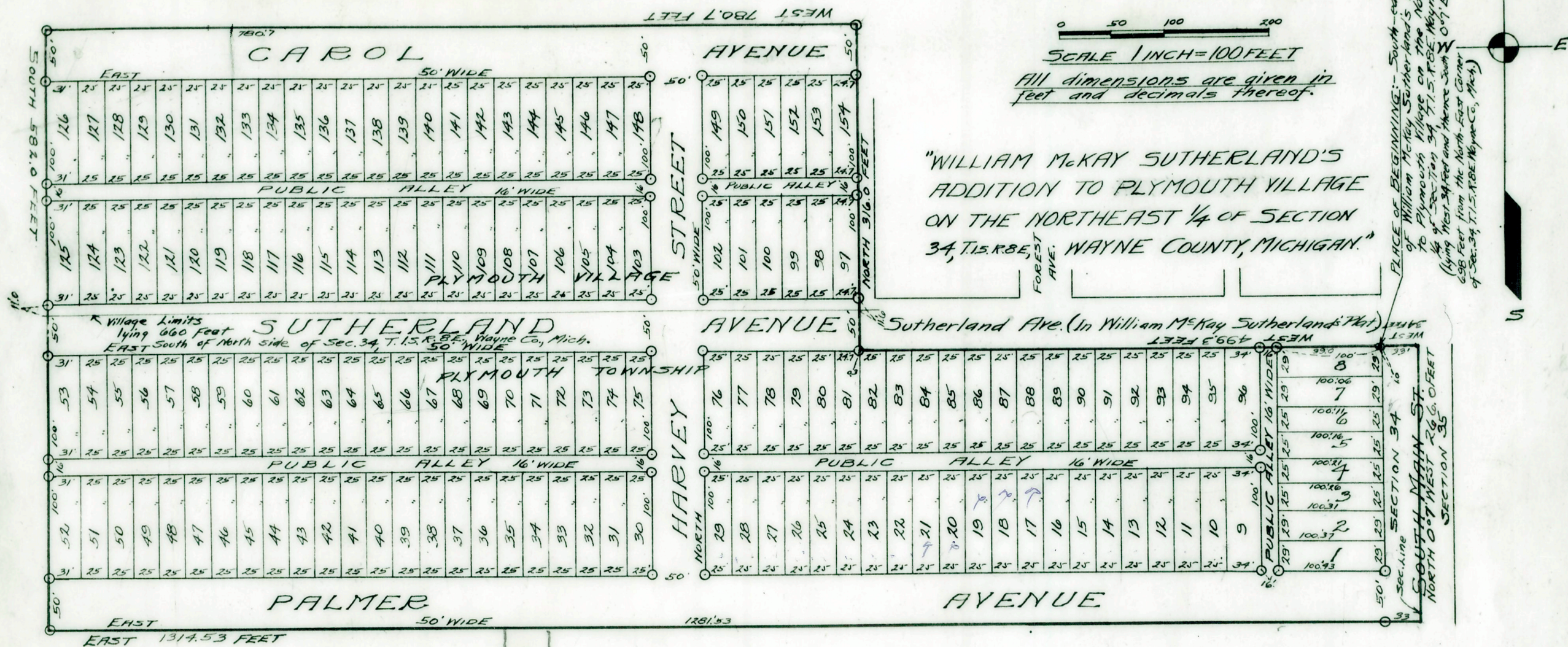

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED.
THE LAND EMBRACED IN THE ANNEXED PLAT OF "Puritan Holm Addition" in the Village of Plymouth and Township of Plymouth, on the North-East 1/4 of Section 34, T. 15. R. 3E., Wayne County, Michigan IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:— BEGINNING AT THE SOUTH-EAST CORNER OF "WILLIAM MCKAY SUTHERLAND'S ADDITION TO PLYMOUTH VILLAGE ON THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34, T. 15. R. 3E., WAYNE COUNTY, MICHIGAN" (Said corner lying West 34 feet and thence South 582.0 feet from the North-East Corner of Section 34, T. 15. R. 3E., Wayne County, Michigan); THENCE FROM SAID SOUTHEAST CORNER WEST 494.3 FEET ALONG SOUTH SIDE OF SAID SUTHERLAND PLAT; THENCE NORTH 316.0 FEET ALONG WEST SIDE OF SAID SUTHERLAND PLAT; THENCE WEST 780.7 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 582.0 FEET; THENCE EAST 1317.53 FEET; THENCE NORTH 0° 7' WEST 266.0 FEET; THENCE WEST 34 FEET TO PLACE OF BEGINNING, BEING ON THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34, T. 15. R. 3E., WAYNE COUNTY, MICHIGAN.
