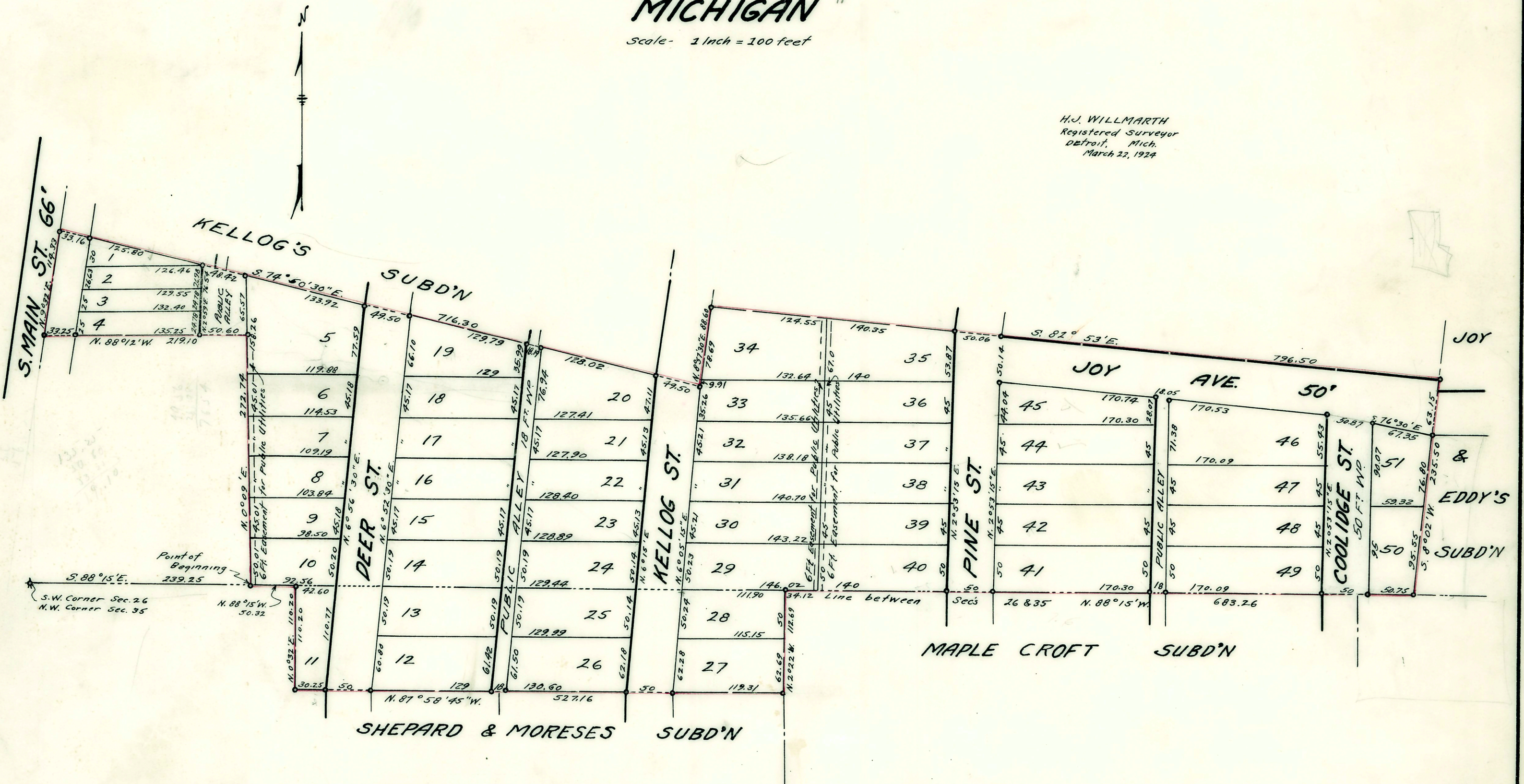

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED.

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "REISER & STELLWAGEN SUBD'N" of part of the S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 26, and part of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 35, T. 1 S. R. 8 E. Village of Plymouth, Wayne County, Michigan, is described as follows; Beginning at a point in the South line of Sec. 26 as above described S. 88° 15' E. 239.25 feet from the S. W. corner of said Sec. 26, thence N. 0° 09' E. 272.74 feet to a point; thence N. 88° 12' W. 219.10 feet to a point in the center line of S. Main St. thence N. 9° 32' E. 114.33 feet along said center line to a point; thence S. 74° 53' 30" E. 716.30 feet to a point; thence N. 8° 57' 30" E. 88.60 feet to a point; thence S. 82° 53' E. 796.50 feet to a point; thence S. 8° 02' W. 235.50 feet to a point in the South line of said Sec. 26; thence N. 88° 15' W. 683.26 feet along South line of said Sec. 26 to a point; thence S. 2° 22' W. 112.69 feet to a point; thence N. 87° 58' 45" W. 527.16 feet to a point; thence N. 0° 32' E. 110.20 feet to a point in the North line of Sec. 35 being also the South line of said Sec. 26; thence N. 88° 15' W. 50.32 feet along the South line of said Sec. 26 to the point of beginning.
