 Point of beginning.

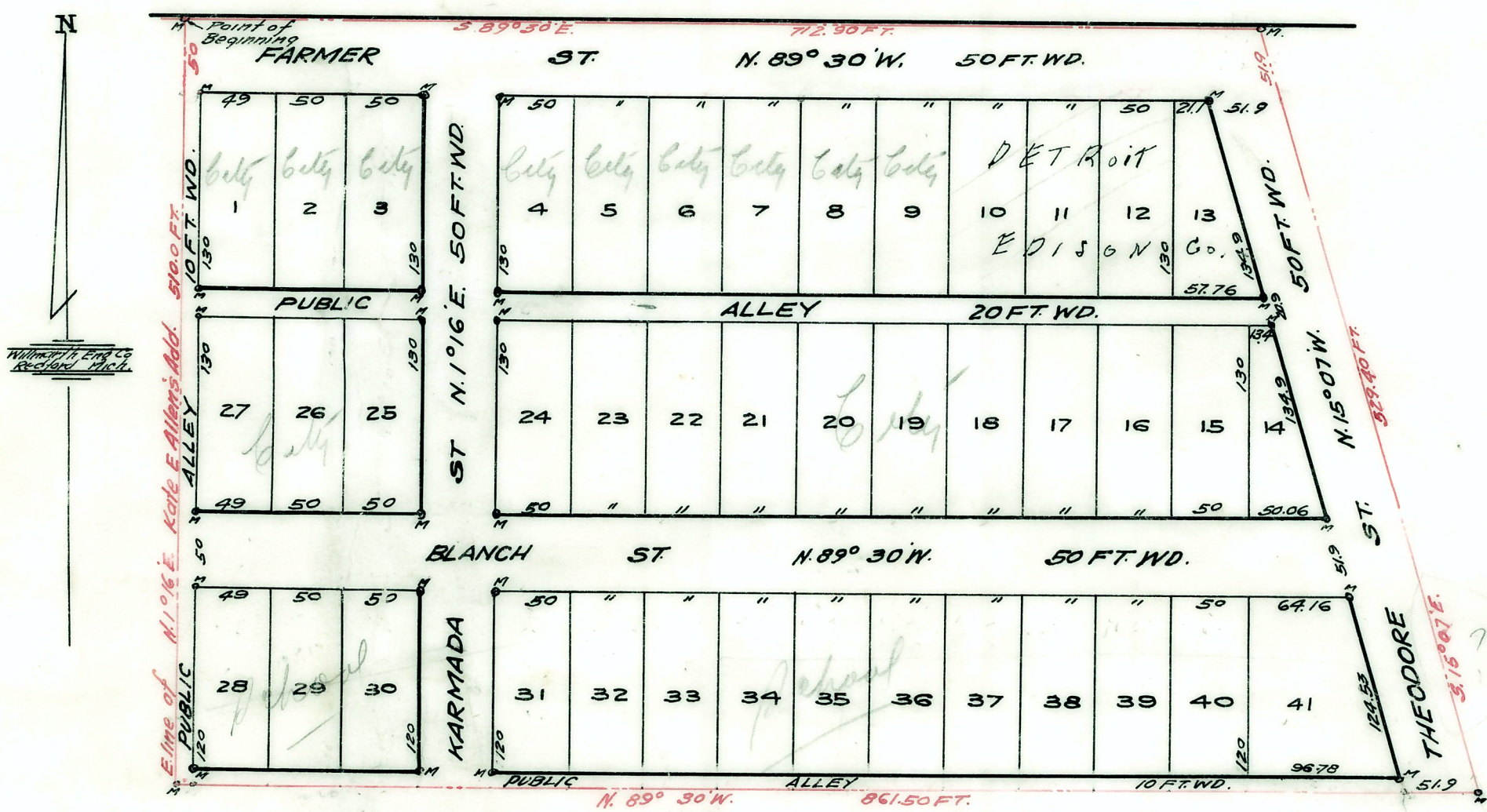
