

Project Scope

- 1. Reviewed drawings and scope of work, including:
 - a. Majority of the work is related to the replacement of the east stair and structural support of the pedestrian bridge.
 - b. Miscellaneous concrete and sealant repairs at the pedestrian bridge.
 - c. Floor drain replacements at the upper level of the parking structure.
- 2. Project pricing is lump sum with unit price adjustments.
- 3. Contractor is responsible for obtaining all permits necessary to complete the work.
 - a. No cost for permits. 5 to 8 business days to process.
- 4. Contractor is responsible for providing appropriate shoring.
- 5. Stairway design shall be performed by the supplier. Refer to Specification Section 05 50 00.

Project Phases & Schedule

- 1. Anticipated Award Date: September 13, 2022 (subject to DDA approval)
- 2. Earliest Mobilization date is September 14, 2022 (following Fall Festival).
- 3. Completion date of concrete and waterproofing work is October 28, 2022.
- 4. Substantial completion date of Project is December 2, 2022.
 - a. Material lead time for metal fabrication will be considered.
- 5. Liquidated damages of \$1,000 per day.
- 6. Construction hours are 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., 7-days a week.

Construction Phasing

- 1. Traffic flow shall be maintained to all levels of the structure, including Fleet Street.
 - a. Short term closures (1 to 2 weeks) of the pedestrian bridge and/or Fleet Street may be accommodated with advance notice.
- 2. Protect pedestrian traffic throughout and around perimeter of parking structure.
- 3. Contractor shall provide a phasing plan prior to start of construction.
- 4. Contractor shall only close areas where work is currently being performed.
- 5. Contractor shall provide a weekly work schedule prior to performing work for the upcoming week.
- 6. Refer to Drawing G002 for complete Phasing Notes.
- 7. Staging/laydown area available below vehicular ramp.
- 8. Employee parking shall be within the work area.

Testing

1. Special inspections at the owners' expense, including steel, concrete, and soils.

Closeout Documents

- 1. Record drawings and warranties are required at the end of construction.
- 2. Refer to Specification Section 01 77 00 for complete Closeout Procedures.

Walkthrough

- 1. A walkthrough was performed following the pre-bid conference.
- 2. Additional site visits do not need to be coordinated with DDA or Fishbeck.

 Install deck coating (full system) at repairs where there is existing deck coating, including concrete, sealant, and floor drain repairs. The supported slab and pedestrian bridge have an existing deck coating.
- 2. Are floor drains to be hot dipped galvanized?

 Yes, provide heavy duty galvanized 12-inch diameter floor drains with sediment buckets and heel-proof, vehicular grate.
- 3. What is the shoring design load?

 Design service (unfactored) load of the temporary support at the new column location is 46,000 pounds.








3 BRIDGE CONNECTION - EXISTING CONDITION
